EDM WINS GREATER CHINA BUSINESS OF THE YEAR AWARD 2017

We beat a host of other top businesses in the North West to win the prestigious Greater China Business of the Year award at an evening ceremony held at The Lowry Theatre in Manchester in February. Organised annually by the UK Department for International Trade, the award recognises the achievements of businesses that have been successfully exporting products and services to the Greater China region for over three years.

Having won orders in excess of £25m since 2008 and establishing ourselves as the world's leading manufacturer and supplier of cabin crew training simulators to airlines in Greater China, we were once again successful having last won this award in 2012 and coming runners-up in 2013.

OUR CABIN CREW TRAINING SIMULATORS FOR CATHAY PACIFIC REACH HONG KONG

After travelling by sea for over a month all the way from the U.K. our two Cabin Emergency Evacuation Trainers (CEETs) for Cathay Pacific have finally arrived in Hong Kong. The B777 and A330 CEETs will join our B777, A330 and B747 Door Trainers which are already at the airline's training centre in Cathay City at Hong Kong International Airport. Once installed and operational, these state-of-the-art cabin crew training simulators will be used to enhance the training of Cathay's highly proficient crew in the handling of emergency situations and provision of cabin services to passengers.

EDM WINS CABIN EMERGENCY EVACUATION TRAINER ORDER FROM MAJOR U.S. AIRLINE

We have recently won a contract from a major U.S. airline to manufacture a combination B787 / B777 Cabin Emergency Evacuation Trainer (CEET). Designed to meet the training requirements of the airline and the Federal Aviation Authority (FAA), the CEET will enable cabin crew to be comprehensively trained in B787 and B777 safety emergency procedures (SEPs) including fire and smoke training, door and exit operation, secure cockpit procedures and emergency equipment usage. The trainer will include six training doors with the front left and right doors fully functional B787s and the rest fully functional B777s.
